Background

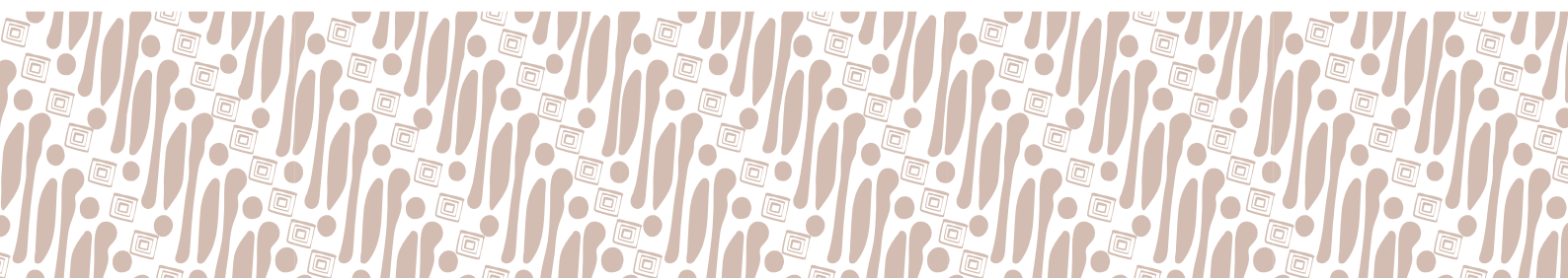
